

MCRP OFFICIAL NHL PLAYOFF DRAFT RULES

DRAFT ORDER

The draft order will be determined the night of the Draft. Upon arrival, a representative from the team will choose a random card. The card will determine which draft group, which pick in the draft and which table your team will be seated at.

DRAFT PROCEDURES

Every team will pick 12 skaters

We will use a snake draft to pick players for the teams - Going up then down the draft order completes 2 rounds

Pools of 8 - 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8 - 8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1

Pools of 9 - 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9 - 9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1

Pools of 10 - 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10 - 10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1

At the completion of the 6th Round, there will be a break for supper. This will be a maximum of 1 hour in duration.

There will be basic player and team information supplied but nothing else. Come prepared! No assistance will be given by the referees or any other people associated in the draft in regards to players, injuries, etc.

Teams will have **30 seconds** to make their selection - if you fail to make a selection in the allotted time then you will be skipped over until the next round where you will get your regular selection plus the one you missed from the previous round.

You will write your selection on the required paper and submit it to your designated referee at the time of your selection. The team is responsible for keeping track of all players being picked. In the event you pick someone who has already been picked by another team you will be notified by the referee and you will lose that player and pick. You will then have to wait for the next round where you will get your regular selection and the one from the previous round.

SIZE OF POOLS

Based on the number of teams entered in the draft we will have either 3 - 4 draft pools.

- a. 24 Teams - 3 pools of 8
- b. 27 Teams - 3 pools of 9
- c. 30 Teams - 3 Pools of 10
- d. 32 Teams - 4 Pools of 8

*32 teams will be the maximum allowed to enter the draft this year (2016-17)

ACCESS TO THE DRAFT INFORMATION

Once the teams have been drafted, all 3 or 4 pools (depending on number of teams entered) will compete against each other in the playoff draft - we will use www.pickuphockey.com to host our draft and every team leader will receive a daily email update beginning on Monday, April 20. This website will also be accessible from the MCRP's website - www.mcrp.ca.

SCORING

Skaters

- 1 Point will be awarded for Goals
- 1 Point will be awarded for Assists

PAYOUTS

- 1st Overall Points - \$5000
- 2nd Overall Points - \$2500
- 3rd Overall Points - \$1000
- 16th Overall Points - \$560

TIE BREAKING CRITERIA

If the top teams have the same amount of points the winner will be determined by this order. This same criteria will be used to determine 16th place. If 2 or more teams are tied, the team that sits in 16th place when the below criteria is applied will be awarded the money for 16th place.

1. Most Goals Scored
2. Most Game Winning Goals
3. Most OT Goals

If this does not produce a winner then the top teams will split the prize money accordingly:

- 2 Teams tied - Split \$5000 + \$2500 equally the next team will get 3rd place - \$1000
- 3+ Teams tied - Split \$5000 + \$2500 + \$1000 equally

REGISTRATION FOR NEXT YEAR

Every team that registers this year is guaranteed a spot in next year's draft if they decide they want to keep it.

Contact information for your team will be held, and those teams in this year will be contacted prior to seeking new entries.

CALCUTTA AUCTION RULES

All 16 NHL teams that are in the 2016-17 NHL Playoffs will be up for Auction. You can purchase more than one NHL team.

All NHL team purchases are final – You must pay for your purchased team the night of the draft, April 9, 2017. – We accept cash, cheque and VISA/MasterCard

If you put up your hand to bid and win the Auction on an NHL team, you are claiming responsibility for the amount of money that your bid was made on.

Calcutta payouts – Payouts are 60% of the total sum of all the winning bids in the auction. 40% goes to the MCRP. If the team you purchased

- **WINS THE STANLEY CUP** – 30% of the overall money bid in the Calcutta is won
 - **MAKES IT TO THE STANLEY CUP FINAL AND LOSES** – 15% of the overall money bid in the Calcutta is won
 - **MAKES IT TO THE CONFERENCE FINAL AND LOSES** – 7.5% of the overall money bid in the Calcutta is won
-
